Chief Strelchuk:

As you are busy with planning, can one of your Paramedics meet with me to help me understand the many differences between the BLS with Star ALS transport that Lake Orion was using in the attached 2015 article and our ALS system? You are quoted in the article. She points out that on the second page that the OCMCA representative seems unconcerned about Star's lack of conformance to OCMCA standard of 90% < 10 minutes for transport. I think this is a lesser level of unconcern than being unconcerned about our initial ALS response times, but I am not sure.

An email will not do it. Only face-to-face will suffice.

I made this summary of the article's data in this table below

The other municipalities including ours provide average data except Rochester Hills. The Rochester Hills Chief explains the very misleading nature of averaging. But Rochester Hills response times more logically include 90 sec of 9-1-1 telephone time. So it looks worse than it is compared to others including OCMCA who do not include that time.
