2. This Agency agrees to comply with the Oakland County EMS Response Time Standards. (See EMS Response Time Standards 8-13)

COMPLIANCE: If any of the above criteria cannot be met, the provider will submit documentation of the exceptions.

It is our intent to act in accordance with the Oakland County EMS Response Time Standards, (See EMS Response Time Standards 8-13) but have not achieved the ambulance response time benchmarks as outlined in the protocol.

In 2014, the Oakland County Medical Control Authority (OCMCA) conducted a response time study, that included data collected from each participating agency. Dr. Tressa Gardner, DO, Professional Standards Review Organization Chairperson, presented an overview of the study at an OCMCA Board of Directors meeting. Her slides from that presentation indicate that findings identified that “many Life Support Agencies were not meeting the OCMCA response time criteria”. Recommendations included the necessity to “identify if the OCMCA response time protocol needs modification”.

In 2015 and 2016, at regular protocol committee meetings, Greg Ball offered discussion from the floor [non-member] no fewer than three times, to create a sub-committee to open and review OCMCA, System Protocols, EMS RESPONSE TIME STANDARDS (September, 2013). At one meeting, Gary Proctor, Sub-committee Chair, agreed to make the motion; no second to the motion could be found. The group strongly felt that the last “opening of this protocol” was very contentious, it was divisive and the sub-committee had worked on it for almost a year.

Charter Township of Oakland Fire Department

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The Oakland Township Fire Department believes that for North America, in life-threatening emergencies, providing a transport-capable unit within 8:59 with 90% reliability is the most common urban benchmark. Common rural and wilderness benchmarks are within 15/90% and 30/90%, respectively. Response time targets have been shaped by position papers published by the American Heart Association, the American College of Emergency Physicians, the National Association of EMS Physicians, the National Fire Protection Association and the Commission on the Accreditation of Ambulance Services.

Establishing unified and consistent EMS response expectations for the Oakland County Life Support Agencies that match or approximate national benchmarks are needed.

For your review, I have attached fractile response time reports for the Oakland Township Fire Department, from current Michigan EMS Information System data.

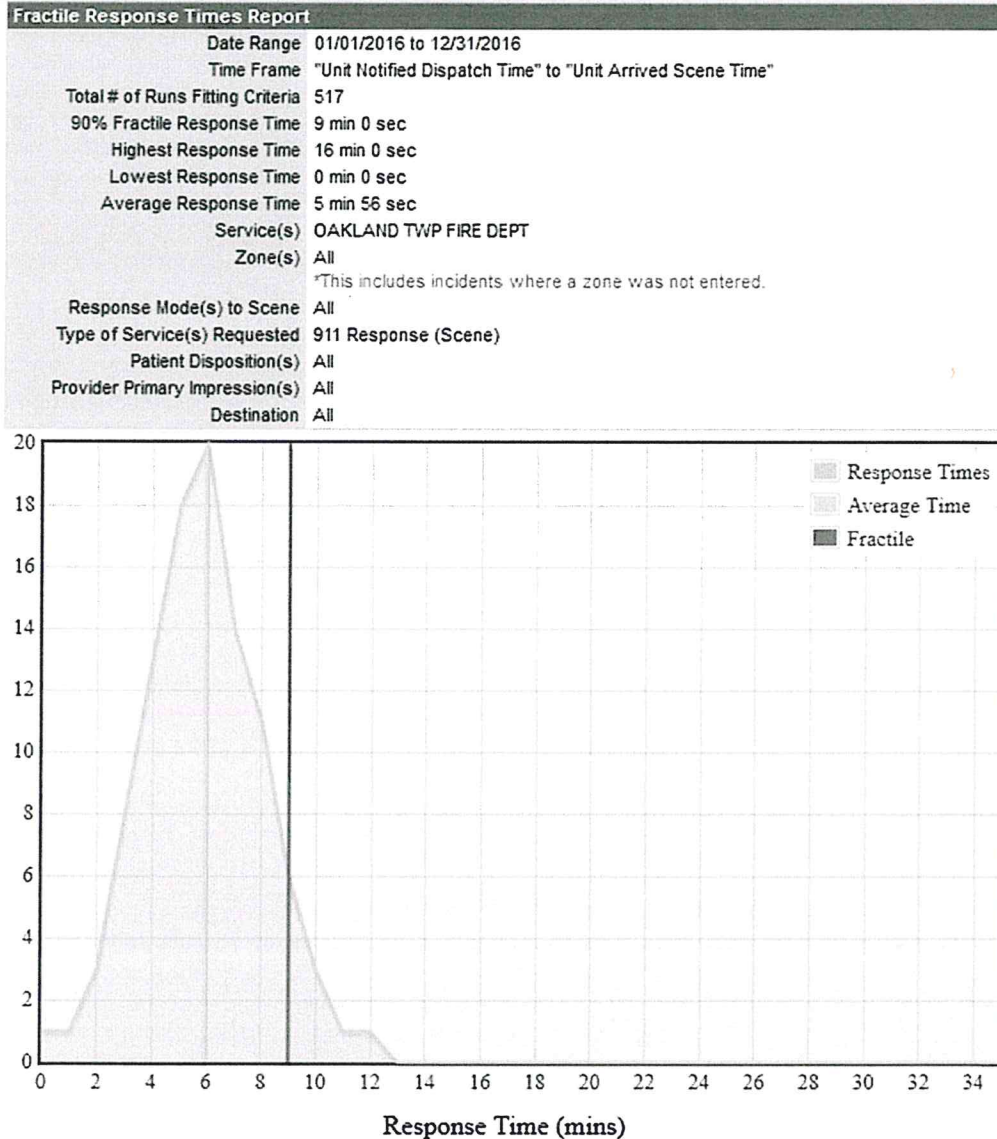

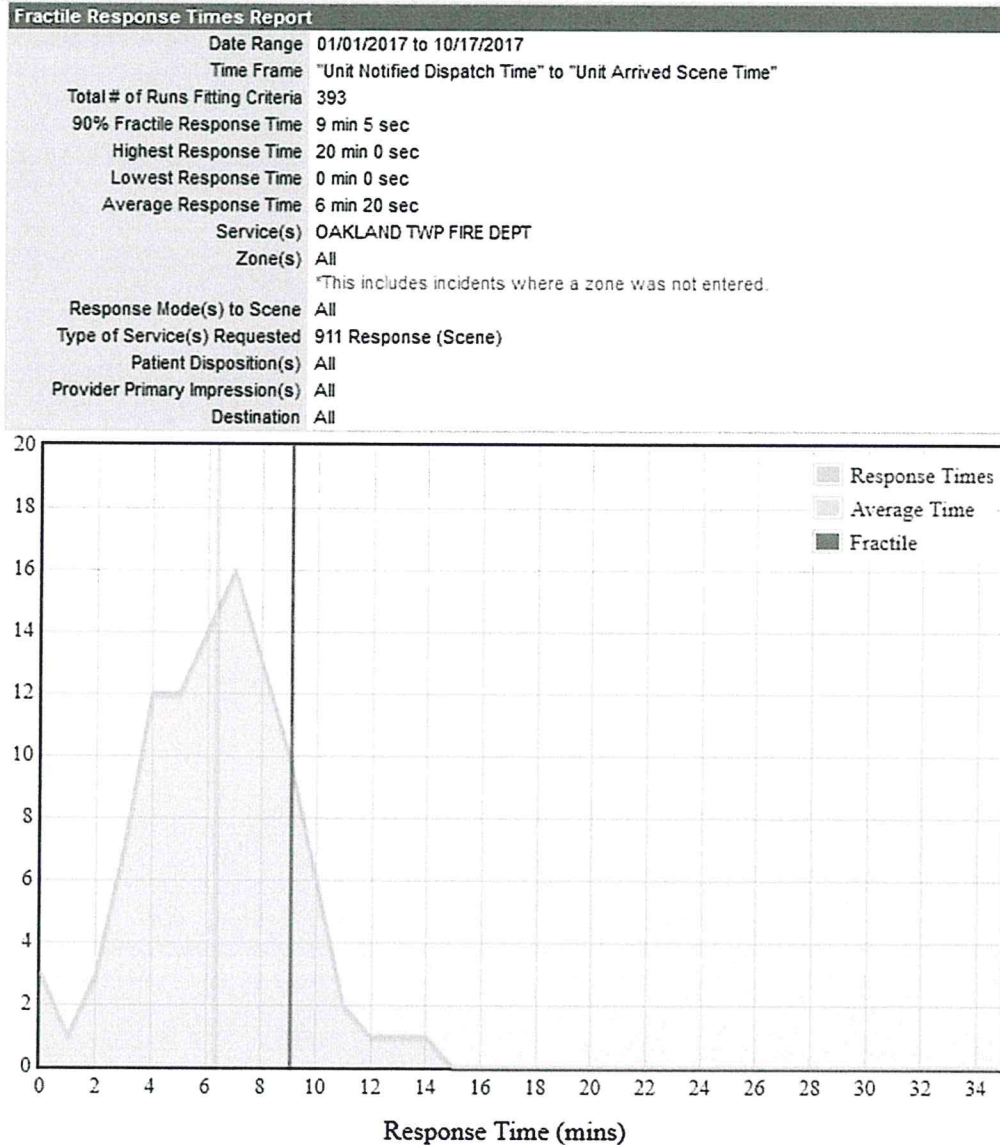

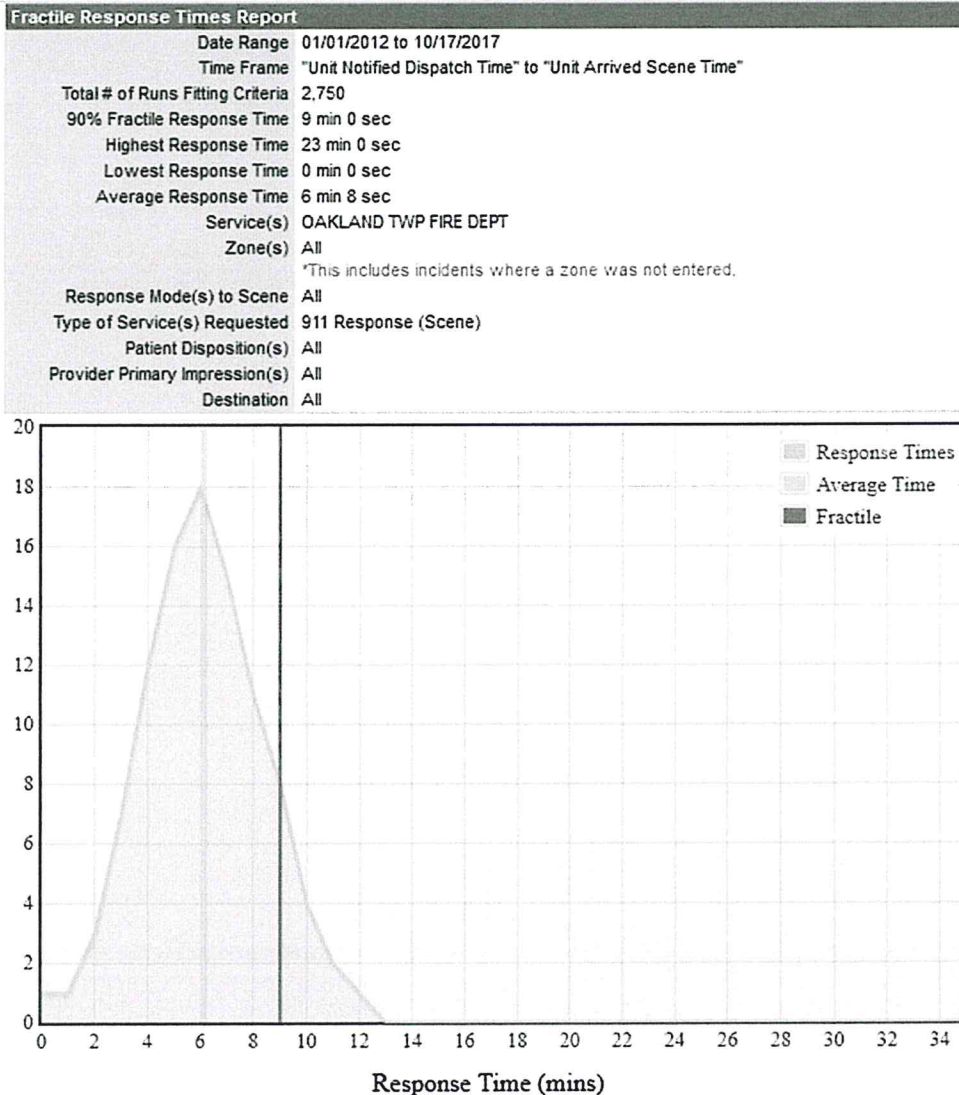

Page 8 is a table of all Oakland County Agencies [Municipal & Private-from OCMCA website], created by Greg Ball, it may contain errors, but attempts to show each Agencies' service area designation type, Tiered or not, and emergency response time requirement.

I have included the information for PSRO review, hoping that to those familiar with our standards and Agencies, it shows that many Municipalities are not meeting the Oakland County EMS Response Time Standards 8.13.

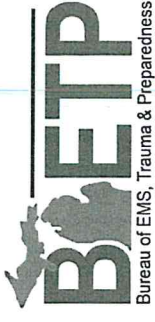
