
Larger Water Bill in Your Future?


If you live in either the Southeast or Southwest Oakland Township community well water districts you are going to have an approximately \$16,000 extra on your water bill to pay over 20 years for Michigan EGLE (formerly DEQ) mandated water storage tanks. A site for the Southeast District was just approved (2/11/20) by the Township Board at the site where the Knorrwood Pines West Well House is now located west of Rochester Road. See the red arrow below. This will be an approximately 500,000 gallon tank.

Detailed planning will take place over ensuing weeks and months. Watch township Board agendas for this item on the meeting agenda, if you want to give input. You can also word-search the township Board minutes on-line for past discussions of this topic.

A site for the Southwest district has not yet been determined.
